



### **Specialty 081 "LAW"**

*For those who are eager to find themselves in advocacy or engage in notarial activities; for those whose minds are made up to dedicate their lives to the law and justice, to the public order protection, or performing in any other legal activity*

#### **As a result of studying in the "Law" specialty, you will acquire professional competences as follows:**

1. Use of professional knowledge in the fields of constitutional, municipal, criminal, civil, family, labor, housing, land, agrarian, environmental, economic, administrative, financial and other fields of law, in criminology, criminalistics, forensic medicine, in the field of international law for protection of constitutional human rights and freedoms or legal advice and consulting, resolution of other issues arising in the specified areas.
2. Keeping records, drawing up drafts of contracts and agreements, legal acts and statements, lawsuits and complaints (along with appeals and cassation), notarial, local regulatory acts and other legal documents.
3. Registration of legal entities of various organizational and legal forms and public formations, as well as legal support of economic and entrepreneurial activities.
4. Participation and representation of the party in court trials on criminal, civil, economic and administrative cases in all court instances, as well as in enforcement proceedings.
5. Investigation, analysis and assessment of the case circumstances, interpretation and correct application of substantive and procedural legal rules, conducting the correct legal qualification, making decisions on the case in accordance with current legislation.
6. Application of recent methods in solving legal issues, acquisition of skills in working with modern equipment, digital law databases, official digital registers.
